DIRECTIONS TO LAMOTH

The Los Angeles Museum of the Holocaust (LAMOTH) is located in the northwest corner of Pan Pacific Park just south of the Post Office.

From the Santa Monica Freeway (10)

Exit Fairfax Avenue North (Proceed north)
Right on W 3rd Street (Proceed east)
Left on The Grove Drive
(The Museum is on the right side of the street,
just south of the Post Office, in Pan Pacific Park)
Park at the bus turnaround located on The Grove
Drive near the entrance ramp to the Museum

From the San Fernando Valley (101S)

Exit 9C toward Highland Ave/Hollywood Bowl
Merge onto Cahuenga Blvd West
Continue onto N. Highland Ave.
Right on Beverly Blvd (Proceed west)
Left on The Grove Drive
(The Museum is on the left side of the street,
just south of the Post Office, in Pan Pacific Park)
Park at the bus turnaround located on The Grove
Drive near the entrance ramp to the Museum

UNLOAD and LOAD passengers at the bus turnaround.

The bus *will* be able to park at the bus turnaround for the duration of your tour.

***Note:* LAMOTH is NOT affiliated with the Museum of Tolerance.
LAMOTH is a different organization located in a different part of the city.**
